English	6 semester hours	English I- Writing English II- Communication Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	6 semester hours Each course must include a related lab.	Biology I Biology II And corresponding labs Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry* General or Inorganic	3 semester hours One course must include a related lab.	General Chemistry I General Chemistry II And corresponding labs
Chemistry* Organic or Biochemistry	6 semester hours One course must include a related lab.	Organic Chemistry I Organic Chemistry II And corresponding labs.
Physics	6 semester hours One course must include a related lab.	Introduction to Physics I Introduction to Physics II Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	Psychology Other psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

^{*} Total Chemistry must equal 12 or more semester hours.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum *cumulative* GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP).
