POLICY STATEMENT

While enrolled at National University of Health Sciences (NUHS), all matriculating students are required to participate in Co-Curricular Learning (CCL). CCL is a mission-driven graduation requirement. It encompasses community service activities that support the University and the public, while focusing on leadership and management, cultural diversity and ethics, and advancement of education.

Procedures

Minimum CCL requirements are listed below by academic program:

Chiropractic/Naturopathic	10
Masters in Herbal Medicine***	9
Masters in Acupuncture***	7
MS in Advanced Clinical Practice	3
MS Diagnostic Imaging	3
Bachelor's Degrees	3
Massage Certificate	3

All students in the College of Professional Studies must complete the last three (3) assignments while in the clinic.

Procedures and process for completing CCL activities can be found in the current NUHS Bulletin.

*Dual enrolled students will only complete the pre-clinic requirements of their highest degree being earned but will complete three (3) clinic requirements for each program in which they are enrolled.

**Transfer students who come to NUHS with substantial transfer credit will be awarded CCL credit based upon their trimester.

***As the doctorate in Acupuncture and Herbal Medicine is an accelerated online program, the CCL requirements will only be for those of their respective masters programs.
