The budget listed in your award letter is based on enrolling in 12 credit hours for the term(s) listed. At the start of each trimester and before financial aid is released to your account, your registration status will be reviewed. If you are registered for fewer than 12 credit hours and/or for courses not required in your letter from the Admissions Office, your budget and estimated financial aid will change. Financial aid program amounts are applied to your account after the first week of the term, since your course enrollment must be reviewed against Admission Office pre-professional requirements for you.

Most students are awarded ...

1. 50% Pre-Professional Tuition Waiver An *estimated* amount that is applied to your student account after the start of the term and after course registration is complete. These funds are applicable only if you meet the following criteria:

- it is applicable only for courses required in your letter of admission, AND
- you submitted an application for a professional (DC, ND) program at NUHS.

2. Federal Stafford Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized Loan Awarded based on the below assumptions:

- applicable only for courses required in your letter of admission,
- you submitted an application for a professional program at NUHS, AND
- you are registered for 6 or more hours (half-time student status) in required courses for admission into an NUHS professional (DC, ND) program.

Additional information about Federal Stafford Loans:

- are distributed twice per trimester – DISB 1 is at the beginning, and DISB 2 is mid-way at the start of Session II coursework; and
- only can be received for *two* trimesters of Prerequisite coursework.

If you register for courses *not* required in your letter from the Admissions Office, and/or you do not submit an application for a professional program at NUHS, the financial aid awarded to you will be rescinded. Please contact the Financial Aid Office if you have any questions.
