English	6 semester hours	<i>ENG 212 Writing in Culture</i> <i>COM 112 Communication in Culture</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 151 General Biology</i> <i>BIO 161 Human Biology</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology. And corresponding labs.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHM 121 General Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 122 General Chemistry II</i> And corresponding labs
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHM 231 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 230 Organic Chemistry I Lab</i> <i>CHM 232 Organic Chemistry II</i> <i>CHM 233 Organic Chemistry II Lab</i> And corresponding labs.
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHY 211 Physics I</i> <i>PHY 212 Physics II</i> And corresponding labs Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course. And corresponding labs.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 111 General Psychology</i> Other psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual. And corresponding labs.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
